Our YEAP! project

The main objective of **YEAP!** project is to foster the labour market integration of young people, empowering education and training in order to create their own business, by instilling an entrepreneurial mindset and developing the necessary skills to succeed.

Encouraging entrepreneurship is particularly important to face challenges related to alarmingly high youth unemployment rates in most of the EU Member States. Evidently, entrepreneurship and self-employment offer pathways for young people to emerge from unemployment.

The project developed a "Youth Entrepreneurship Advanced Pathway" promoting entrepreneurship education and social entrepreneurship among young people to support them in

becoming active, creative and entrepreneurial citizens.

Project results have been disseminated at European level to promote its future application in other geographical areas. This represents a key objective of YEAP! project, as transferability of the action programme, approach and methodology will be the most effective way to ensure its impact and continuity.

YEAP multiplier event in Sweden





The multiplier event in Sweden took place on the 22.09.2020 at Folkuniversitetet's premises.

23 people attended the event, including representatives of young peounemployed ple, youth, and youth workers.

FU project officers presented the project, its objectives and activities, as well as the main intellectual outputs: the YEAP! Flexible

Learning Pathway, the Youth Workers' Methodological Guide. Workers' Youth Toolbox, Business Idea Assessment Guide and the Youth & Social Entrepreneurship e-tools Data Base.

Apart from this, the participants were given a presentation about entrepreneurship from the Professor at Department of Business Studies of Uppsala University, Ivo Zander.

The participants enjoyed the event and provided only positive feedback regarding the project results presented to them.

FU-Uppsala has made a strong effort to give visibility of the event prior to its implementation, in order to achieve great participation impact. 3500 and people were reached with Facebook advertising, with 130 people indicating they were coming or were interested to come.

Participants gave positive feedback about the intellectual outputs of the project. They mentioned that the agenda included many topics related to their interests.

YEAP Multiplier event in Greece

The Federation Hellenic Associations of Young Entrepreneurs (OESYNE) organized 2 online multiplier events for disseminating the YEAP project results.

The first multiplier event was organized in collaboration with Dimitra Education & Consulting and was titled "Youth Entrepreneurship: From theory to practice". The event took place 30/06/2020. 17.00-21.00 EEST and attracted 65 participants. The event was also broadcasted via Facereaching book live, 1.1K views.

The second multiplier titled event was "Youth Entrepreneurship: Opportunities and challenges", took place on 29/09/2020, 16.00— 18.00 EEST online via zoom and had 82 participants. The event was also broadcasted via Facebook Live reaching 703 views.

In both events, participants were informed about the aim, objectives and partners and all five intellectual outputs of YEAP project were presented, making also a tour on the project's website for the audience.

A panel of experts partic-

ipated in each event, forming discussions on social entrepreneurship and resilient sectors of the economy, for the enhancement the learning experience and dissemination of the project.

YEAP Multiplier event in the UK

Rinova's YEAP Multiplier event took place 29th of September 2020, 14.00-15.30 BST as a webinar on Zoom. event was titled "Pathways to Creative Enterprise YEAP!" and placed an emphasis upon Youth Enterprise Coaching in the creative industries. It was planned and hosted in partnership with Tomorr Kokona, Creative Enterprise Business Coach. through whom the event reach was extended via social media groups numbering over

1500 followers, in addition to Rinova's own networks. The event was simultaneously

livestreamed via Facebook to private groups, who could also access the video of the event afterwards.


